



# Grower Exemption Form

## TEXAS PECAN CHECK-OFF

A statewide Texas pecan check-off was approved by Texas pecan growers on August 25, 1998. As a result, an assessment of one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) cent per pound of inshell pecans is to be collected by the first handler of the pecans and remitted to the Texas Pecan Board. All Texas pecan producers having at least 500 pecan trees on at least 15 acres are subject to this assessment.

I, the undersigned, do hereby declare that I am not subject to the statewide Texas pecan assessment of one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) cent per pound of inshell pecans because I do not meet the above stated criteria, namely at least 500 pecan trees on at least 15 acres.

I understand that this form will be filed with the Texas Pecan Board which is authorized under the Texas Commodity Referendum Law to institute legal proceedings to recover amounts due to the board.
